COMMENDATION FOR COURAGEOUS ACTION

522220 DEPUTY CAPTAIN ANDREW VINER

Deputy Captain Andrew Viner is commended by Fire & Rescue NSW for his courageous actions at a storm and flood emergency in the Hunter region.

On 20 and 21 April 2015, Fire & Rescue NSW crews and other emergency services responded to multiple calls relating to a storm that brought heavy rain, widespread flooding and damage. 282 Station Dungog arrived on the northern side of Stroud to find themselves faced with a number of arduous and confronting incidents to respond to. There were reports of houses in Cowper Street submerged in rising floodwater with trapped occupants, a number of people stranded in the showground's grandstand and toilet block, and a car with a camper washed way with persons reported trapped inside.

Due to the rising floodwater, the crew set out to conduct search and rescue operations in homes that were submerged by the rising flood water. In extremely dangerous conditions, the crew removed several occupants including young children and pets, whilst wading through fast moving flood water over 1.5 metres in depth in some places, and having to form a human chain to safely rescue one family. If it were not for the actions of Deputy Captain Viner, some residents in Cowper Street Stroud may not have survived.

Fire & Rescue NSW commends Deputy Captain Andrew Viner for his courageous actions, which were in the finest traditions of the service.






