Swim School Update

Swim school is now full and we are looking forward to our lessons starting on the 19th November. Just a few reminders for you to help with your preparation for Monday.

Students will need to bring to school each day a towel, goggles, swimmers, **rash shirt**, swim cap or hair tie for long hair, spare underwear, a strong plastic bag for wet items, recess and fruit break items and a water bottle. I will have our school sunscreen available for students however, if you prefer your child to wear their own, please pack it in their bag. All students attending the scheme, will need to wear their swimmers under their uniform in order to be ready on time. Please note that our first lesson starts at 10am so we will need to be on the bus at 9.15am. Please ensure your child is at school in time to catch the bus as we will be unable to wait for late comers. All items of clothing (including goggles and towel) will need to be clearly marked with the student's name. There will be no opportunity for the children to use the canteen facilities except on our last day of lessons where we will endeavour to have a pre-ordered lunch. We should be back at school in time for lunch so the children can order their lunch here on canteen days.
