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Outline of Activities

Stage 3 (Years 5 and 6)	Aboriginal Traditional Basket Weaving Students learn about the history of Aboriginal Basket Weaving, materials and contemporary vessel shapes. Each student will be using grasses to make their individually unique basket.
Stage 2 (Years 3 and 4)	Gratitude Plaque/Rock Painting Students are given information about Aboriginal symbols so they can choose a symbol for their Plaque/Rock. This workshop educates students about gratitude and how important it is to be grateful every day. Each of the students will have a Gratitude Plaque/Rock to keep and take home.
Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2)	Painting a Dreamtime Story Students learn about Aboriginal Culture by listening to, discussing and illustrating a Dreamtime Story with standardised Aboriginal symbols used correctly.
Kindergarten	Dreamtime Story Students learn about Aboriginal Culture Through listening and sharing understanding of a Dreamtime Story.
